

It takes 5-10 gallons of water per minute to water the lawn and flowers.

The average person uses 80 gallons of water per day for personal use. However, they only need 4 gallons per day.

The average person drinks 3.5 gallons per water per week.

A steady drip in a faucet wastes 20 gallons of water a day.

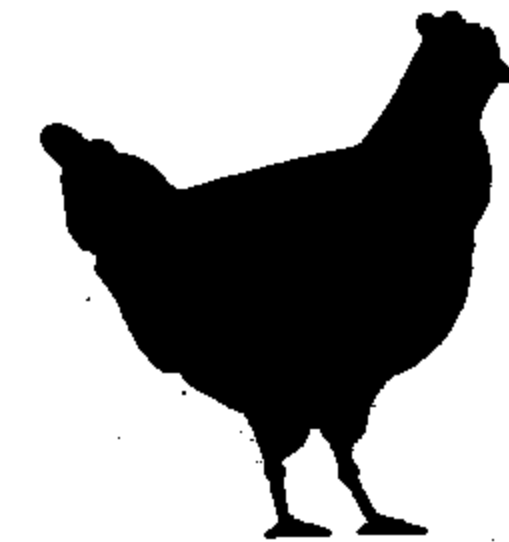
A leaking toilet wastes 200 gallons of water a day.

A 1/8" leak in a pipe wastes 400 gallons of water a day.

An fully opened fire hydrant uses 1,000 gallons of water per minute.

One ton of recycled paper saves 7,000 gallons of water.

The human body is made up of 70% water; a chicken is made up of 75% water; a pineapple is made up of 80% water; a tomato is made up of 95% water; an elephant is made up of 70% water; an ear of corn is made up of 80% water; an earthworm is made up of 80% water.



It takes 11.6 gallons to process one chicken and 9.3 gallons to process one can of fruit or vegetables.

It takes 5.4 gallons to make one foot board of lumber and 24 gallons to make one pound of plastic.

A person can live approximately one month without food. However, a person can only survive approximately one week (depending on conditions) without water.
