Proposals for presentations for AEA training programs, workshops, and conferences. Abstracts are Being Sought From

Executive directors, CFOs, operators, operators, financial, accounting, management, human resources professionals, public officials, regulators, engineers, scientists, consultants, sales representatives, manufacturers, academics and others with expertise, knowledge and skills applicable to the management of water, wastewater and solid waste facilities in New Jersey. *Preference given to submissions from AEA member organizations.*

Audience

AEA conferences and workshops are attended by decision-makers (commissioners, executive directors and managers), staff, professionals, licensees, and service providers associated with local water/wastewater/solid waste utilities.

Topics

Those interested in presenting should complete Proposal Submission Form.

Our Education and Conference Committee has identified topics for which we are ***especially interested*** in receiving proposals. Submissions should consider the topic in a forward looking way. The proposals should emphasize techniques, approaches, likely trends, and developing solutions useful in coming five to ten years (and even beyond if applicable):

- COVID19 (testing, safe workplace practices, lessons learned, preparing for Round II)
- Financial implications/financial planning of the economic impacts of COVID-19
- Data management in the cloud/electronic protocol implementation
- Future outlook: Tariffs/construction costs
- Leadership / employee motivation/morale
- Community Relations / Public Education
- Protecting Utility from Cyber Threats

- Flooding, CSOs and SSOs OR Arsenic, Phosphorous and other Permit Limits
- Case studies relating to Barnegat Bay, the Delaware River, the Pinelands, the Passaic River, New York Harbor and the Hudson.
