AEA Take on Parts of Recently Proposed Rules: DEP Did Not Rely on Science

AEA recently submitted letters of comment on two very important matters, the proposed reclassification of about 800 miles of rivers and streams in the State to Category One, and the proposed new MCL for PFOS/PFOA.

These rules will impact many AEA members.

In the letters, AEA noted that aspects of both proposals appeared to be backed up by incomplete data or no directly applicable data. In the April 17 letter, AEA also noted that the Cat 1 proposal did not align with Executive Order 63, in which Gov. Murphy outlines his ground rules for the regulatory process.
