At Monday's Board meeting the Commissioners approved the adoption of the NJ Health Dept Travel Advisory dated July 28, 2020. With this, employees are advised should they travel to the states listed below for vacation or otherwise, they will have to self-quarantine upon their return for 14 days. This will be by the use of vacation, personal, sick or comp time or no pay by use of furlough time. There are a few exemptions such as business travel, critical infrastructure workers such as healthcare and law enforcement. I have the complete Advisory as well as your supervisor should you want to read it. The States included at this time are:
