Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Webinar set for Thursday

A webinar on the assistance the NJ DEP will be providing via the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) will take place this Thursday at 10am.

The BIL allocates an estimated **\$501 million** to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) over the next 5 years to make transformative investments in **critical water infrastructure upgrades**. A portion of that funding will be set aside to provide technical assistance to water systems in NJ.

This webinar will focus on the types of **technical assistance** NJDEP will be offering in conjunction with its technical assistance providers. The objectives are to assist water systems in disadvantaged communities by assessing their needs and identifying eligible projects for Drinking Water and Clean Water SRF funding.

The **DEP will be providing engineering services** for planning and design of identified projects and performing outreach to encourage program participation.
