- 1. Fall Protection General Requirements (1926.501): **5,260 violations**
- 2. Hazard Communication (1910.1200): 2,424
- 3. Respiratory Protection (1910.134): **2,185**
- 4. Ladders (1926.1053): **2,143**
- 5. Scaffolding (1926.451): **2,058**
- 6. Lockout/Tagout (1910.147): **1,977**
- 7. Powered Industrial Trucks (1910.178): **1,749**
- 8. Fall Protection Training Requirements (1926.503): **1,556**
- 9. Personal Protective and Lifesaving Equipment Eye and Face Protection (1926.102): **1,401**
- 10. Machine Guarding (1910.212): **1,370**
