OCTOBER INCIDENT DISCUSSION

QUESTION FOR SAFETY COMMITTEE/EMPLOYEE DISCUSSION:

An employee entered a sludge holding tank to inspect a mixer without performing atmospheric testing or using a gas monitor. Residual hydrogen sulfide caused dizziness and coughing. While trying to exit, he slipped on sludge, suffering minor chemical burns and a twisted ankle.
